General Rules for Crafts and Arts Allowed by the Market Committee

- *All craft/art items must be hand-made.
- *No Buy/Sell craft or art items (no direct resale).
- *All crafts/art must be of quality workmanship (no splinters, loose threads, etc.)
- *No items made from kits or copyrighted materials other than your own designs.
- *Each new or different product offered for sale must be approved by the Market Committee prior to offering the item for sale.
- *Consigned items must be approved prior to offering the item for sale by the Market Committee and follow the same rules/regulations.

All work will be rated upon the following criteria on a point system. Each of these areas will be given a score of 1-5, 5 being excellence.

- *Quality of Workmanship
- *Originality/Creativity of the item being offered
- *Attractive Packaging and Display Set-Up
- *Appropriately Pricing Item Offered
- *Product appropriateness in conjunction to Farmers' Market
- *Number of other Vendors currently selling similar items

To the best of my knowledge all of the information provided is truthful and accurate and proof of misrepresentation will be grounds for termination as a vendor with the Freight House Farmers' Market, Inc.
